Sail & Sign Card

Please keep your room key with you at all times. It is used to purchase shore excursions, drinks, photos, casino coins & chips, laundry service, tuxedo rentals, infirmary services and gift shop items. It can also be used to purchase goods and services at art auctions, formalities, Internet café, & Spa Carnival. Additionally, your Sail & Sign card is your "boarding pass" to exit and reboard the ship while in port. Again, please keep it with you at all times.

Wake Up Calls

Want some help waking up? You can set a wake up call from your stateroom phone by dialing 37 and the military version of the time you would like to receive the call. For example, if you would like an 8:00am call, simply dial 37 then 0800. Or, for 8:00am, dial 37 then 2000. To remove unwanted wake up calls, dial * then 37.
